Dear Permittee/ Lessee:

We have enclosed your annual Grazing Application for the upcoming grazing year (March 1, 2019- February 29, 2020). This form provides you the opportunity to apply for non-use or to make changes you may have relating to livestock numbers, kind of livestock, or season of use. These changes should be made in the space above the preprinted information.

Please be sure to also complete the items at the bottom of the form. These include the reason for any non-use, recording your brands and earmarks, and signing the form and returning the "Case File" copy to changes to your grazing application, or you wish to pay for your full permit, you do not need to return the grazing application and your bill will be issued at your full permitted numbers. The Actual Use forms (Yellow Forms) will be mailed with your grazing bill in February.

Precipitation

Judging from forage conditions on the allotments, it appears that most of our Field Office area received adequate precipitation late this last year.

We appreciate that many of you have voluntarily cut back on your numbers or have implemented alternative management strategies to cope with past dry conditions. Please be assured that if you decide to continue with these voluntarily reductions (non-use) in livestock numbers due to dry range conditions on your ranch or uncertainty about the upcoming year, it will not negatively impact your grazing permit or lease.

Range Improvements

If you are planning on constructing range improvements such as fences, pipelines, etc. please remember that all range improvements on public land require a Cooperative Agreement to authorize them. Be sure to contact us as soon as possible as this will allow plenty of time to schedule the necessary clearances, complete the Environmental Assessment and issue the Cooperative Agreement without putting you in a bind.
